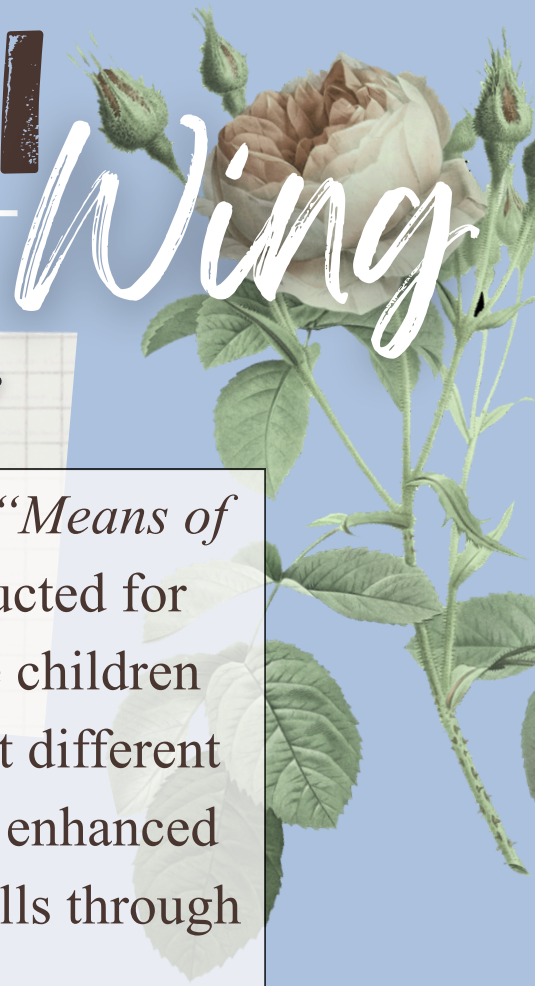

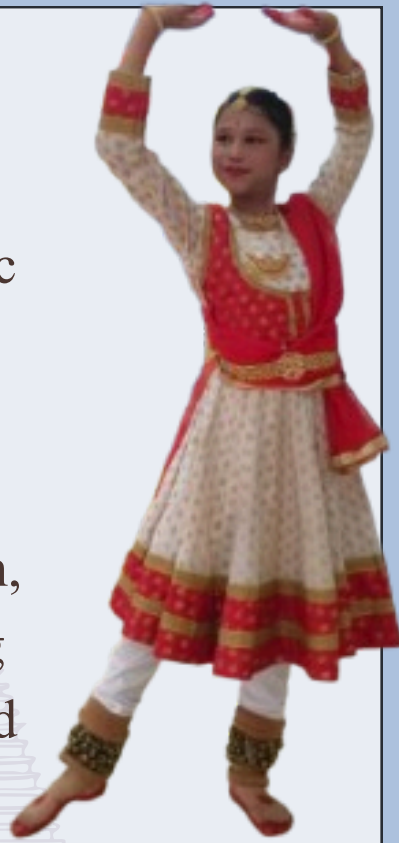


Grade V students were engaged in a basic **Stitching activity** conducted by the *Vocational Club*. The activity helped develop life skills, patience, and creativity.
